**PART II: INFORMATION CONCERNING THE ALLEGED VIOLATION**

YOU OR YOUR COMPANY IS BELIEVED TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FOLLOWING VIOLATION(S) OF MAINE'S ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS, RULES, OR DEPARTMENT ORDERS.

SUMMARY OF FACTS ALLEGED AS BASIS FOR VIOLATION(S):

On March 27, 2007 Department staff conducted a site visit at Twin Brook Campground. During the inspection it was found that fill material has been placed in wetlands within 250 feet of Little Sebago Lake. A search of Department records indicates a permit for this activity was not issued by the Department.

LIST SPECIFIC VIOLATIONS BY APPLYING FACTS TO SPECIFIC STATUTE(S), RULE(S), OR ORDER(S) VIOLATED:

By disturbing soil in a freshwater wetland without first obtaining a permit from the Department, Calvin Austin violated the Natural Resources Protection Act, 38 M.R.S.A. § 480-C.

REQUESTED CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):

By May 1, 2007 submit an acceptable after-the-fact permit application for this filling activity to the Department. During the site visit the Department waived this project to a tier 1 application. After-the-fact applications require double the fee or \$70.00 in this case. If an acceptable application is not received by May 1, 2007, removed all recently placed fill to the Department's satisfaction by May 31, 2007.

**TIMELY COOPERATION ON THE CORRECTIVE ACTIONS REQUESTED IN THIS NOV, AND CONTACTING THE CASE MANAGER BY PHONE OR IN WRITING WITHIN 7 DAYS OF RECEIVING THIS NOV ARE TWO SIGNIFICANT FACTORS THAT MAY AFFECT WHETHER, OR THE EXTENT TO WHICH, THE DEPARTMENT PURSUES FURTHER ENFORCEMENT ACTION.**
