Dear Ms. Doucette,

I am responding to your letter on behalf of the Little Sebago Lake Association dated September 19, 2007, in which you requested to be added to the list of interested persons regarding the expansion application for Twin Brooks Campground in Gray and any other future proposed development within the Little Sebago Lake Watershed.

The Stormwater Management Permit Application for the Twin Brooks Campground has been withdrawn. Please check the newspapers circulated in your area for a Notice of Intent to File for future submissions of this project. If the project is resubmitted, it will be reviewed to meet the requirements of the Stormwater Management Law, the Site Location of Development Law and the Natural Resources Protection Act. At that time, the file can be made available for review by the Association. Please contact me in advance to arrange for the file review.

I encourage you to contact the Town of Gray to express your concerns regarding unpermitted expansions relative to local ordinances.

In response to your request to be notified of other projects in the watershed, the Department does not have the resources to provide the Little Sebago Lake Association with this type of information. I suggest that you stay in contact with the towns in the watershed and review local public notices.

A copy of the GIS aerial photo from the file was previously sent to Tom Williams of the Little Sebago Lake Association on September 18, 2007.
